



Flagship Commons served more than 25,000 diners in first week

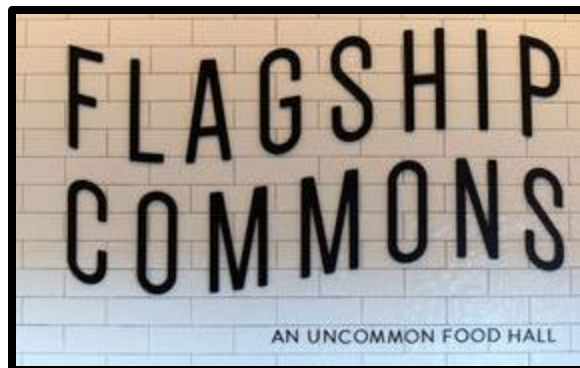

Flagship Commons has been open at Westroads Mall since Dec. 29 and in its first week served more than 25,000 diners, said Flagship spokeswoman Megan Longo.

She said that so far, all of the new concepts in the food hall have been embraced equally by diners. Wait times were longer than they would have liked during opening week, she said, but have been reduced.

The seating area in the space will be reconfigured to include an additional 83 seats, bringing the total seating in the food hall to a little over 500. Longo said many customers have not realized that the food hall stays open until 10 p.m. on Friday and Saturday evenings, which is later than the rest of the mall.
