



Blatt Beer & Table to Open in Preston Hollow Village

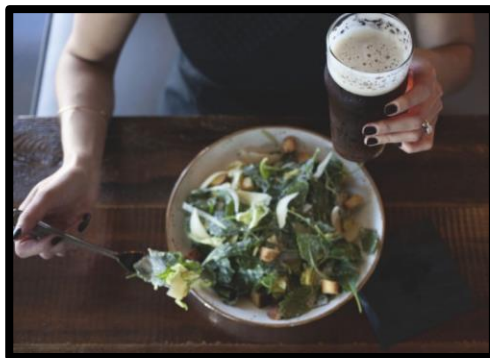
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The first Texas location of craft beer bar and restaurant, **Blatt Beer & Table**, will open this spring in Preston Hollow Village. The restaurant from Flagship Restaurant Group (which is based in Omaha, Nebraska) will be located at the intersection of Walnut Hill Lane and Central Expressway. According to the release:

The restaurant's atmosphere will be comprised of reclaimed materials highlighting the history of Dallas. Blatt will have multiple TVs featuring sports games; however the ambiance will maintain a casual sophistication and communal vibe...The menu features elevated beer hall fare including housemade sausages, burgers, chicken and waffles as well as vegetarian options. Menu favorites include homemade Bavarian Pretzel Bites, Falafel Sliders and Vegan Currywurst. In addition to Vegan Currywurst, Blatt's menu will feature several other vegan and gluten-free options. Alongside the food, Blatt will mainly focus on craft and local beers featuring 30+ handles and another 40-50 varieties in bottles. Blatt will be a hub for those who appreciate craft beer and curated pub food.

"Many of the fans who attend the College World Series each year hail from Texas, and Blatt has become a 'must do' while in Omaha for the event," says Anthony Hitchcock, COO of Flagship Restaurant Group in a statement. "That said we feel Dallas is perfect for our next Blatt location...The concept itself is not at all a 'baseball bar and grill,'" Hogan continues. "We actually refer to it as a 'non-sports-bar' sports bar. It really is a great place to go for a beer and to watch a game, but the food definitely stands on its own." The restaurant is slated to open in the spring.



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
