



KETV gets sneak peek of Westroads Mall's new dining hall

OMAHA, Neb. —It's been 18 months in the making, and now **Flagship Commons**, the new dining hall at Westroads Mall, is set to finally open in just a few weeks.

There will be nine eateries offering 220 new jobs.

Many customers will notice some familiar dining, like Blatt Beer & Table, and Aromas Coffeehouse. But new concepts are on the way, too, like Yoshi-Ya Ramen, Omaha's first authentic ramen shop. Roman-style pizza can be enjoyed at Weirdough Pizza Company, and custom salads can be made at Clever Greens.

One of the most anticipated features of the new hall is a full-service bar.

"We're going to have a ping-pong table, a foosball table and higher level of energy; different level of music," Flagship Restaurants Group CEO Nick Hogan said. "It's just all the things you might expect from a first-class full service operator translated to a fast, casual environment."

Over 400 seats of dining will allow customers to cozy up around the large fireplace in the center of the hall.

Final inspections begin next week, and the tentative opening date for Flagship Commons is Dec. 21.

Most restaurants at the existing food court will close by the end of the year.
