



5 Things To Know About Blatt Beer & Table in Preston Hollow Village

Blatt Beer & Table opens today as the latest addition to upscale neighborhood shopping center Preston Hollow Village, where it joins [Pakapo](#), [Matchbox American Kitchen + Spirit](#), [Modmarket](#), [VERTS Mediterranean Grill](#) and [Blue Sushi Sake Grill](#), which is part of same Flagship Restaurant Group in Omaha, NE, that started the Blatt [chain](#).

1. Even though it's named after the original home of the College World Series, Rosenblatt Stadium, it's a "non-sports bar" sports bar. Sure, you can pass the time playing shuffleboard or watching an epic rivalry on one of the many TVs, but the owners of Blatt Beer & Table like to stress that this isn't your typical beer hall full of rowdy bros. The food is the primary focus and they want this to be the major draw with options for carnivores, vegetarians, vegans and those with gluten sensitivities alike. The full menu is posted at the end of the story.

2. Almost everything's made from scratch, including their sausages. Everything from the pretzels to the fries to the sauces is made daily by chefs on-site. Sausages are one of the biggest sellers at the other locations, and include options like beer-braised bratwurst, jalapeño Polish sausage, smoked kielbasa and even a *vegan* currywurst. Sausages can be ordered on a stick or on a bun.



3. Happy Hour is a big deal. Happy hour specials are available every day of the week with hours Monday–Saturday, 3–6:30 PM and Sunday from noon–8 PM. Most everything on the special menu costs \$5 or less with the biggest deal being a 16-oz. PBR for two bucks. All other beers are \$1 off. The full happy hour menu can be viewed below. In celebration of the grand opening, the happy hour menu will be available all day Wednesday, April 27, through Sunday, May 1.

4. You can get chicken and waffles for dinner. Because you shouldn't have to wait for Sunday brunch to get this craveable combination. The chefs have kicked things up a notch with crispy fried chicken strips and jalapeño cornbread waffles with orange-honey butter, peppercorn gravy and real maple syrup.

5. Beer. Beer Cocktails. Beer Dessert. With beer in the restaurant name, it should come as no surprise that there are plenty of options, with more than 30 on tap and upwards of 50 by the bottle or can. They even have special reserve brews perfect for celebrating, including a 750ml Sriracha Hot Stout Beer for \$45. Beer makes its way into their Guinness Bloody Mary (pictured above), cheese spreads, batter for fried items and even dessert where you can indulge in a beer float made with Samuel Smith's Organic Chocolate Stout and vanilla ice cream. Or perhaps an Irish brownie with Guinness baked right into the batter is more your speed.
